The Florida Local Environmental Resource Agencies, Inc. (FLERA) began in the late 1960s as a voluntary association of county and municipal environmental programs to share information about mutual resource concerns and solutions.

Today, FLERA is a diverse statewide organization of state and local agencies and consulting firms. Our members provide environmental protection services in air and water quality monitoring, growth management, land management, and environmental health.

FLERA Services and Activities

- Educational meetings to provide training on current issues.
- Annual conference providing practical training, technical presentations and current information on environmental issues.
- Advocacy for environmental resource agencies with the Florida Legislature.
- Electronic newsletter on issues of concern to local environmental programs and professionals.
- Networking with federal, state, and local environmental professionals involved with similar activities and concerns.
